LOCATION: The conference location for the 48th ISCSC Conference in 2018 is Suzhou (Soochow) University, Suzhou, Jiangsu, China PRC

DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION: Conference Registration deadline is **April 14, 2018**. Registration Instructions and payment information are found on the ISCSC website. <http://www.iscsc.org>. Although the deadline to register is April 14th, please consider the time necessary to acquire a Chinese visa depending on your country of residence.

COST TO REGISTER: Registration cost is \$225 U.S. (\$175 U.S. for students). Registration cost *includes* a one-year membership in the ISCSC; an opportunity to present at the conference*; subscription to *Comparative Civilizations Review*, the ISCSC professional journal; and the many benefits of affiliation with scholars around the world.

HOSTS: Our hosts at Suzhou (Soochow) University are Professors Fang Han Wen, Director of Comparative Literature and Comparative Civilizations, and Shi Yuanhui, Vice Dean School of Foreign Languages. Professor Fang is ISCSC Vice President of Coordination to China.

HOTEL, SUGGESTED ARRIVAL and VISA APPLICATION: Conference participants should plan to arrive in Suzhou (Soochow) no later than June 14th or preferably a couple of days prior to the initial conference date for hotel check-in. Our hosts have arranged for us to stay at the nearby Suzhou Dongwu Hotel. It is a short distance to the School of Foreign Studies at Soochow University where conference sessions will be held. The reduced hotel price per night for our conference group is approximately 400 RMB (approximately \$60 USD) per night, for either single or double occupancy. Upon your completion of Conference Registration and Payment, a hotel reservation will be

made for you by our Chinese hosts. They have secured the preferred hotel rooms for our group. Your payments to the hotel will be made individually, on-site, upon arrival.

A confirmation of your hotel reservation along with an invitation letter from our Chinese hosts will be sent to you from the ISCSC upon their completion. These documents may assist you in obtaining your travel visa to China. Visa applicants from the United States should apply for "Type F" visa to China.

MEALS: Breakfast is included at the host hotel and a banquet/dinner will be provided for all attendees during the conference. Other meals are on your own and locations will be suggested or otherwise made available.

AIRPORT & TRANSPORTATION: Attendees can fly to Shanghai Hongqiao Airport or Shanghai Pudong Airport, either of which has easy access by bus or express train to Suzhou Railway Station. Additional travel details will be added to the ISCSC website as they become available. Travel to Suzhou may be easier and of shorter duration from Shanghai Hongqiao Airport. Either airport has transportation links to Suzhou.

Plans are being explored to have university student volunteers to assist conference attendees on-site.

PRESENTATIONS AT THE CONFERENCE*: If you are interested in presenting a paper at the conference, please see our Call for Papers (CFP) document which is also on the ISCSC website, <http://www.iscsc.org> and consider submitting an Abstract according to the instructions. The deadline to submit Abstracts is March 20, 2018. A *Poster Session* in addition to formal presentations is under consideration and included on the CFP.
